OBJECTIVE: Students will create an acrostic poem using the letters of their name as well as adjectives to describe themselves to the class.

PROCEDURE: Please read the requirements below and be sure to check them off as you create your poem:

- Students should use both their first and last names in their poems.
- Their names should appear vertically and the letters of their names should stand out. (Refer to the example on the board)
- Students will write simple sentences properly forming adjectives to describe their personality. They will write sentences for each of the letters of their name.
- They are to state what they are like and what they are not like.
- They are to utilize a minimum of 10 adjectives.
- Projects should include a photograph of the student and should be illustrated to depict what the student is like.

GRADE: Students will be graded using the attached rubric. They will be graded on their use of adjectives and other vocabulary terms, creativity, following of directions, spelling/mechanics, and content.
