3. The feminine form of those ending in *-o* is made by changing the *-o* to an *-a*.
4. Nationalities ending in *-és* can be made feminine by changing the ending to *-esa*. Thus the feminine form of *inglés* is *inglesa*.
5. Nationalities in other endings don't have separate masculine and feminine forms.
